Elliot S. Krames, MD, is a board-certified anaesthesiologist who has been practicing pain medicine solely since 1982. He is a pioneer and one of the leading experts in the field of intraspinal analgesia. A worldwide-recognised leader and educator in the field of neuromodulation for pain control, Dr Krames has written extensively on implantable technologies for pain management.

Until 2014 Dr Krames was the Medical Director of Pacific Pain Treatment Centers in the San Francisco Bay Area, an organisation of pain clinics dedicated to interdisciplinary pain medicine. He is co-founder of the National Pain Foundation, a founding member of the North American Neuromodulation Society and has participated on the boards of the North American Neuromodulation Society, the International Neuromodulation Society, the World Institute of Pain, the American Academy of Pain Medicine, and the American Board of Pain Medicine.
